Why would my company want to participate in the COREporate Summer Showdown?

• There are many reasons why participating in COREporate Summer Showdown is beneficial to any business. It helps build team cohesion, increases employee morale, promotes and encourages a healthy lifestyle, increases team pride, and is a cost effective way to let your employees know that you care.

How do I register for a COREporate Summer Showdown at the CORE?

Registrations must be done in person at the CORE. We currently do not offer online registration. Payment can be made in cash, by check, or with a credit/debit card. A team name will be required upon registration.

How old do you have to be to participate?

Employees must be 16 years of age or older. Participants that are 16 or 17 years old will need to have a
Minor Consent Form signed by a parents or legal guardian prior to participation on the day of the event.

Does our business have to physically be in Hobbs to participate?

No. All events at the CORE are available to businesses regardless of where you are located.

We have a small business with only a few employees. Would we be able to combine with another company?

• Yes. If you do combine with another company, we suggest that your team name reflects that. This will help CORE staff verify employment for both companies.

What is included with an event registration?

- All events are double elimination tournaments, 2 games guaranteed.
- Individual prizes will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place teams.

How many events are we able to participate in?

- You can register as many teams as you like and registration fees are all based on how many teams you decide to play with. The breakdown is below:
 - ° One (1) team = \$30. Example: one (1) coed flag football team.
 - Two (2) teams = \$50. Example: one (1) table tennis and one (1) coed basketball team OR 2 coed volleyball teams.
 - Three or more (3+) teams = \$75. Example: Two (2) coed soccer, one (1) Pickleball, and one (1) men's basketball team totaling 5 teams.



EVENTS

What are the COREporate Summer Showdown events?

- Men's Basketball 3v3
- Coed Basketball 3v3
- Coed Soccer 6v6
- Table Tennis 2v2
- Coed Volleyball 6v6
- Coed Flag Football 6v6
- Pickleball 2v2

Where and when are the events held?

• All events will be held at the CORE on specific dates during the summer (June-August). Please see the current COREporate Summer Showdown flyer for detailed event information.



UNIFORMS & EQUIPMENT

Does my team need to have matching uniforms?

• To show company pride and comradery as well as to assist in the officiating of events, matching uniforms are required. Player numbers on the back are highly recommended.

What do I wear?

- Comfortable, athletic, non-restricting clothing is recommended for events. Street clothes including jeans and sandals are prohibited.
- Some events have requirements:
 - $^\circ$ $\;\;$ Basketball/Volleyball/Pickleball: Non-marking athletic shoes are required.
 - ° Flag Football: Non-metal cleats are recommended.
 - ° Soccer: Shin guards are required. Non-metal cleats are recommended.
- Please see the Member Handbook for a complete list of rules regarding proper attire at the CORE.

Will equipment be provided?

 All event equipment will be provided including balls, rackets, paddles, and flag belts. You are allowed to bring personal equipment as well, but official CORE game balls will be used for competition. If you do bring personal equipment, please ensure that it is clearly marked with your name.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

Who can play for my team?

• All participants must be current employees of your company and be able to verify proof of employment. Family and friends are not able to participate but are encouraged to come and support their team.

What can be used for proof of employment?

- Approved forms of verification:
 - ° Company Photo ID
 - ° Photo ID with business card
 - Photo ID with Paystub
 - ° Photo ID with electronic email
 - Photo ID with current Insurance card listing company name and employee name
- Proof of employment is required for play. If a player arrives without proper verification, they will not be allowed to participate.

When do I need to turn in my team roster?

• Team rosters will be filled out during the check-in period, prior to play for each event. Participants who are 16 or 17 years old must have a parent or legal guardian with them during check-in to sign the roster as well as the required Minor Consent Form.
